Foundation Karibu Tanzania's (FKT) vision is the eradication of child domestic violence in Tanzania. In order to achieve this, FKT has four main areas of focus. The first is a Rescue Centre, where temporary shelter is provided for domestically abused children, supporting them with their physical and emotional recovery. Secondly, FKT recognises that for any real change to happen, the adults that have been abusing the children also require support. After they have been released on bail and are awaiting their court hearings, they sign a contract with FKT, the Social Welfare Department, and the Police Department Gender Desk, which obliges them to attend weekly counselling at FKT's Rescue Centre. Thirdly, a re-integration and monitoring programme is implemented with the child and their family. If it is not possible to reintegrate the child with their family, FKT will reintegrate the child with a long term orphanage. Finally, FKT also creates awareness in Mwanza around child domestic abuse. This includes community meetings, cinema showings, monthly educational programmes for potentially violent parents/caretakers, and public service programming in conjunction with the media.

To date, FKT have rescued over 250 severely abused children directly from the hands of their abusers and they have rehabilitated over 200 children either in their reformed families, families of origin, extended families or long term centres. Many more have indirectly benefited from FKT's awareness and educational programmes.

Summary from Assessors



FKT has moved from nascent to growth stage. They have demonstrated success in the projects they have been running and have passionate and committed staff. The Assessors were impressed with how well the project was integrated with the community, e.g. village committees, police, and health centres. The organisation is consistently strong, well managed, and their activities and programmes are logically structured.
