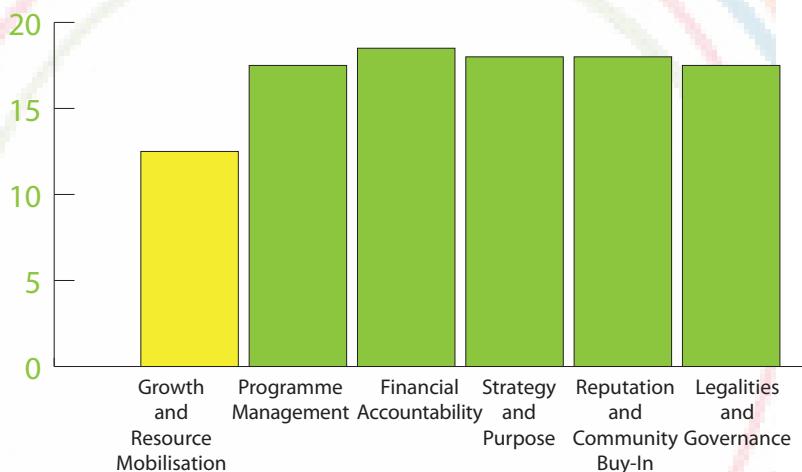

Railway Children Africa's (RCA) vision is a world where no child ever has to live on the streets; its mission is to create and enable sustainable change for children who live alone and at risk on the street.

RCA works at three interdependent levels in order to achieve sustainable and long-term change for children struggling to survive on the streets. 1) Meeting immediate needs – developing and enabling quality interventions for children. 2) Challenging perceptions – so that communities are more likely to support and protect children around them. 3) Strengthening government systems – working to advocate for and co-create with governments, robust laws and systems that respond effectively and empathetically to children on the streets.
