The mission of the Foundation For Tomorrow (TFFT) is to secure quality education and emotional support for most vulnerable children so that they may reach their full potential and thrive in their communities. They do this by: (i) Identifying children who are particularly vulnerable and who would benefit from access to educational scholarships; (ii) working directly with scholars' families to improve their livelihoods and to intervene to address familial dysfunction and distress when necessary; (iii) engaging systematically with key actors in the education and social welfare sectors to address issues that exacerbate children's vulnerability; (iv) supporting schools to become child safe and train teachers and school leaders so that they can offer an improved pedagogy and practice in the classroom.
